He *has* filled the hungry with *good* things, and the rich he has sent *a*-way empty.


He *has* come to the help of his servant *Israel*

As *it* was in the *be*-gin-ning, is now, and will be for *e*-ver. Amen.





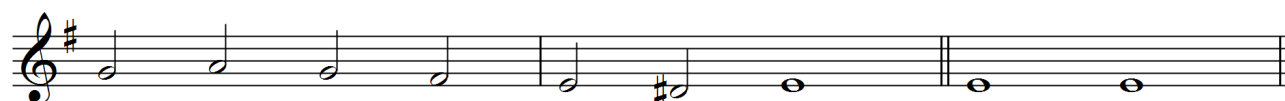
